- [Advanced](#): Passed standard PreBronze or Adult Silver Skating Skills
- [Intermediate](#): Passed Freeskate 1 or Adult 6 to standard Preliminary or Adult Bronze Skating Skills
- [Beginner and Low Beginner](#): In Snowplow Sam 3 or 4, Basic 1 through Basic 6, Pre Freeskate, Freeskate 1, or Adult 1 through Adult 6

Membership Requirement Summary

- All skaters must have a USFS membership.
- To skate in July, skaters must renew their membership.
- If skating more than 3 hours this skating year, must also be a member of the NVFSC or PSU Club Figure Skating and complete the volunteer requirement.

Level and Membership Requirements

There are three levels. Skaters must meet both the level and membership requirements to skate.

Advanced Skaters

To skate on Advanced Club ice, skaters must

- Have passed at least standard PreBronze or Adult Silver Skating Skills, AND
- Be a Full¹ USFS member, AND

¹ Full membership categories are: Introductory, Subsequent Introductory, First Family, Subsequent Family, and Collegiate. If the skater joined NVFSC as their home club without a LTS or Aspire membership, they have a NVFSC Full membership.

- Be a Full or Associate NVFSC member OR be a member of PSU Club Figure Skating if skating more than 3 hours this skating year².

These skaters may skate any Club ice session. Skaters should register for ice time in Acuity using the [Advanced Club Ice](#) option.

Intermediate Skaters

To skate on Intermediate Club ice, skaters must

- Have passed Freeskate 1 or Adult 6 through standard Preliminary or Adult Bronze Skating Skills, AND
- Be a Full¹ or Aspire USFS member OR have graduated from the beginner program this skating year, AND
- Be a Full, Associate, or Junior Associate NVFSC member OR be a member of PSU Club Figure Skating if skating more than 3 hours this skating year².

These skaters may skate any Club ice session. Skaters should register for ice time in Acuity using the [Intermediate Club Ice](#) option.

Beginner and Low Beginner Skaters

To skate on Beginner and Low Beginner Club ice, skaters must

- Be in Snowplow Sam 3 or 4, Basic 1 through Basic 6, Pre Freeskate, Freeskate 1, or Adult 1 through Adult 6, AND
- Be a Learn to Skate (LTS), Aspire, or Full¹ USFS member, AND
- Be a Full, Associate, or Junior Associate NVFSC member OR be a member of PSU Club Figure Skating if skating more than 3 hours this skating year².

These skaters may take private lessons on any Club ice session this summer. Skaters should register for ice time in Acuity using the [Beginner Club Ice](#) option.

For everyone's safety, skaters must be in an in-person, one-on-one private lesson with a coach the entire time they are on the ice.

Graduating from Beginner Club Ice

When a skater who has participated³ in Beginner Club ice passes Freeskate 1 or Adult 6, they graduate from Beginner Club ice! Graduating skaters may skate on Intermediate Club ice for the remainder of the skating year regardless of membership type.

Private Lessons

- All skaters may take in-person private lessons during Club ice.
- Intermediate and advanced skaters may take virtual lessons. New this year, skaters must tell the monitor who they have a lesson with.
- All coaches, both in-person and virtual, must be approved prior to coaching. If a skater is interested in taking a lesson from a coach who does not currently have NVFSC approval, please have the coach email coachcompliance@nittanyvalleyfsc.org for directions on how to become an approved coach.

² The skating year is from July 2025-June 2026. The new skating year starts July 1, 2026.

³ A skater has participated in Beginner Club ice if they have skated at least one 30-minute Beginner Club ice segment this skating year (July 2025-June 2026). The new skating year starts July 1, 2026.

Payment Options

Package - \$145 for 20 segments or \$72.50 for 10 segments

- [20 segment \(10 hour\) option](#): Purchase 20 30-minute segments for a discounted price of \$145, a \$45 savings. You will receive a credit of \$190 that can be used to register for Club ice. The cost is \$7.25/30 min segment.
- [10 segment \(5 hour\) option](#): Purchase 10 30-minute segments for a discounted price of \$72.50, a \$22.50 savings. You will receive a credit of \$95 that can be used to register for Club ice. The cost is \$7.25/30 min segment.
- You must register for ice time in [Acuity](#) before the session.
- The cancellation and rescheduling deadline is 1 hour before the segment starts.
- When you have used all your segments, you can purchase a new package or switch to [pay as you go](#).
- Packages expire on July 31, 2026.
- Immediate family members may share a package.
- The skater must be a NVFSC member (Full¹, Associate, or Junior Associate) or a member of PSU Club Figure Skating. If sharing a package, all family members must meet the membership requirement. Join NVFSC [here](#).

Pay As You Go - \$9.50 per 30 min

- Pay for segments as you need them.
- You must register and pay for ice time on [Acuity](#) before the session.
- The cancellation and rescheduling deadline is 1 hour before the segment starts.
- All non-NVFSC members must have a waiver on file. Fill out the waiver [here](#).
